

## **\*\* 2006-07 BAB/BPAA BASKETBALL SEASON INFORMATION \*\***

The cities of Brooklyn Park & Brooklyn Center form the Brooklyn Area Basketball (BAB) Program as part of the Brooklyn Park Athletic Association (BPAA), offering House League Basketball for boys & girls in grades 2-12.

The program emphasizes fun and equal participation for all players. Teams are comprised of 7-9 players engaging in practices, games and tournaments. Registration occurs in September and the program runs from November-March.

### **Registration Dates:**

- Thursday, Sept. 14, 2006** - Brooklyn Center Comm. Ctr. - 6301 Shingle Creek Pkwy. - 7-9 PM
- Tuesday, Sept. 19, 2006** - Zanewood Comm. Ctr. - 7200 Zane Ave. N - 7-9 PM
- Thursday, Sept. 21, 2006** - Brooklyn Park Comm. Ctr. - 5600 85<sup>th</sup> Ave. - 7-9 PM

### **Registration Fees:**

- Grades 2-6** (Elem. House League) \$80.00 3-5 volunteer hours
- Grades 7-8** (Jr. High House League) \$105.00 & \$35.00 Equip. Dep. 3-5 volunteer hours
- Grades 9-12** (Intramural) \$110.00 & \$35.00 Equip. Dep. 3-5 volunteer hours

**Out of Area Fee:** \$25.00 non-resident fee to be applied for those not attending school or living in Brooklyn Park or Brooklyn Center.

**Financial assistance:** Will be available on a limited basis only at the start of the season. To apply, you must register in person and provide a picture ID and most recent W2 form and pay ½ or more of the registration fee at sign up.

**Late registrations:** Will be accepted for an additional \$10.00 fee. Players will be placed on teams with openings and will need to attend at minimum, 2 practices prior to participating in games.

**Refunds:** Will only be issued prior to the start of games. A \$25.00 processing fee will be deducted from the original fee amount. Refunds will be processed the last week in November. No exceptions.

**Playing Up:** Is not allowed in the BAB/BPAA league.

### **Registration Process:**

- There are many ways to register for the program:
  - 1. In-person during open-house registration.**
    - You will be required to submit a completed registration form and full program fee.
    - Financial assistance will only be available to those signing up at one of the open house registrations.
  - 2. Online at [www.bpaasports.org](http://www.bpaasports.org). Simply click on [Basketball](#) or [Brooklyn Area Basketball](#) and then [Registration](#). Follow the online instructions to enroll.**
    - Online registrations received after September 29<sup>th</sup> will be considered late in which the \$10.00 late fee will automatically be applied.
  - 3. Sign up at the front desk of one of the three community centers noted above.**
    - You will be required to submit a completed registration form and full program fee. Registrations received after September 29<sup>th</sup> will be considered late in which the \$10.00 late fee will be required.
    - Do not drop off your registration form if you are seeking financial assistance.
  - 4. Mail in your registration to Brooklyn Park Athletic Association (BPAA), Attention: BPAA Basketball 2006-07, P.O.BOX 43176, Brooklyn Park, MN, 55428**
    - You will be required to submit a completed registration form and full program fee. Registrations received after September 29<sup>th</sup> will be considered late in which the \$10.00 late fee will be required.
